
Kyujanggak was built as a Royal Library of Joseon Dynasty in 1776. Its original location was in the Royal Palace, Changdeok-gung (昌德宮). The books stored at Kyujangkak were moved into the Library of Keijo Imperial University. In 1974, the library of Seoul National University was moved into Gwanak Campus. The present building was built as Institute for Korean Studies in 1990. It has about 148,819 ancient texts of Joseon and China, and more than 500,000 books and documents in total.


